



Centurions AGM - Saturday 27th January 2018

The Committee has confirmed the AGM will be held on **Saturday 27th January 2018 at 1 pm** (doors open at 12 noon) at the **Mill Hill Chapel, City Square, Leeds, LS1 5EB**. Tel. **No. 0113 243 3845**. It is a Unitarian church in Leeds which dates from the 1848 rebuilding of the chapel. It is in easy reach of Leeds railway station. If receiving this by post a map and directions are overleaf, otherwise Google.

Our host is Martin Fisher C.788. On arrival a buffet will be available, and at 1 pm the President will welcome all present to the AGM. At approximately 2.30 pm there will be a refreshment break during which a short talk on popular city pedestrians will be given. The meeting is scheduled to end at around 4.30 pm. Once again the AGM is being held outside the London area, and there is strong expectation that Centurions will attend from all parts of the country. Leeds is very accessible by both road and rail.

2. It is proposed by John Eddershaw C.299, and seconded, that “The present rule governing the 3 year time limit for the President and the Captain be rescinded”. The purpose is to enable these office holders to continue for another 3 years subject to their election at each AGM.
