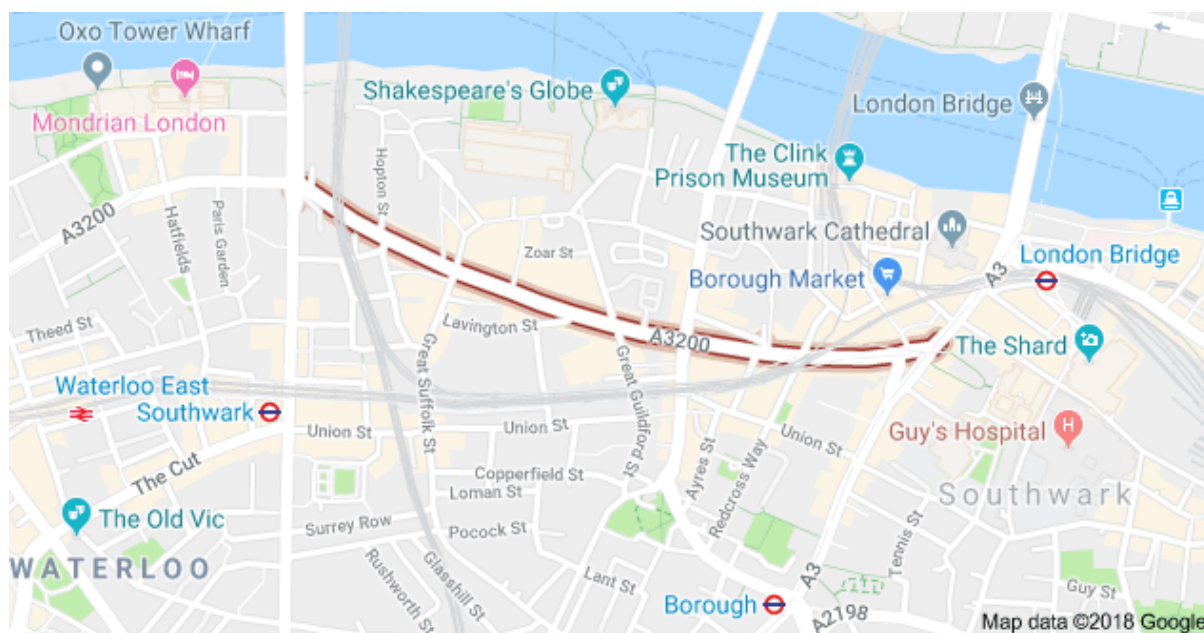




Centurions Annual General Meeting 2019 and Nominations

The Committee has confirmed the AGM will be held on Saturday 26th. January 2019 at 1 pm (doors open at 12 noon) at the **Bankside Community Space, 18 Great Guildford Street, Southwark, London, SE1 0FD. Tel. No. 020 7928 2998.** We are returning to London after recent AGM's at Leicester and Leeds and have used the Bankside Community Space a couple of times before. It is a modern meeting place with facilities for refreshments, seating up to 50 persons, and is situated in a vibrant part of London's South Bank situated between London Bridge and Waterloo Station. Nearest Underground stations are Southwark (Jubilee & Northern lines), Blackfriars (Circle & District line), Borough (Northern line), and London Bridge (Jubilee & Northern lines). From these stations it is easily accessible by foot or bus.

Directions: 18 Great Guildford Street is off Southwark Street (A3200) which is the main thoroughfare between London Bridge and Waterloo. Buses are frequent, Nos.381 and RV1. Get off at stop SW (ask driver). If travelling from Waterloo the bus is recommended.



Nomination

Eric Horwill C390 has been our excellent President for the past 3 years and now stands down.

Proposals

1. It is proposed by John Eddershaw C.299, and to be seconded, that 'The present rule governing the 3 year time limit for the President and the Captain to serve be rescinded'. John's argument is that those holding these positions should be elected annually as with other post holders, and the three year rule is too restrictive.
2. It is proposed by Eric Horwill C390, seconded by Chris Flint C849, that 'A small sub-committee is formed to examine the merits of a Constitution for the Centurions, and to submit a draft report to the 2020 AGM'. Eric says that many aspects of modern life indicate a need for the Centurions to have a written document which lays down its fundamental principles as a unique athletic body and which acknowledges the way in which it is governed/administered.
3. It is proposed by Martin Fisher C788, seconded by Chris Flint C849, that David Jones C987 is elected to the Committee.
