100 MILE OPEN WALKING RACE

Starting from Victoria Park, Leicester at 4.00 p.m.

FRIDAY, 2ND AUGUST, 1974.

AWARDS

The "Skegness" Trophy for the winner (held for one year)

The "Sunday Dispatch" Trophy for the winning team (held for one year)

Plaques to the first three teams - three to score

Time Standard Plaques : 1st Class - 20 hrs. or less

2nd Class - 20 hrs. to 24 hrs.

The British Legion County Chairman's Trophy to the first Ex-Serviceman to finish.

"Centurions" medals to all beating 24 hrs. for the first time.

The winner will be presented with the "Skegness" Trophy on arrival at the Skegness Foreshore Centre, Tower Esplanade, by the Chairman of the Skegness Council.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

By signing the Entry Form you have agreed to accept THE CONDITIONS OF ENTRY as formulated by the Committee of Leicester Walking Club for your own safety. These as follows:-

- (1) Walking on the footpath (unless so directed by the Police or authorised Official) is prohibited as it is being paced or shielded;
- (2) Competitors should not walk more than two abreast (particularly during the hours of darkness). This MUST be complied with if so directed by Police or an Official;
- (3) Attendants or other persons on cycles, motor cycles or in cars must be a minimum of 1 yard in the rear of competitors and not interfere with other competitors;
- (4) Attendants must not walk or run alongside or in front of a competitor except during the actual time needed for feeding or sponging and then only for the minimum time needed for this purpose;
- (5) Any competitor after 50 miles walking outside a 4 miles per hour schedule should retire and notify a Judge of his retirement;
- (6) Leicester Walking Club will provide each competitor with FOUR NUMBERS, 2 will be white linen and 2 of a reflective material. These MUST BE SEWN to the vest in daylight and to a WHITE track suit top or vest during the hours of darkness;
- (7) THESE CONDITIONS HAVE BEEN FORMULATED FOR THE SAFETY OF YOURSELVES AND OTHER ROAD USERS AND IN THE INTERESTS OF RACE WALKING MUST BE COMPLIED WITH AT ALL TIMES AS THEY APPLY.
COMPETITORS NOT COMPLYING TO THE ABOVE RULES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND MUST RETIRE.

DEFINITION OF WALKING

Walking is progression by steps so taken that continuous contact with the ground is maintained, i.e. the advancing heel must make contact with the ground before the rear toe leaves it. Any Walking Judge (or Judges appointed for the race are empowered to disqualify any competitor who fails to comply with the above definition or who fails to walk to the entire satisfaction of any Judge or Judges.

THE COURSE

START: Main Drive, Victoria Park at 4.00 p.m. sharp; proceed via Evington Road, East Park Road to Uppingham Road where turn right and proceed to fork at Trocadero Cinema where BEAR LEFT along Scraftoft Lane to STATION LANE where turn right and proceed to T Junction with main Uppingham Road (A47) where turn right and proceed to Peterborough entering over steel bridge, here bear left along the A15 to Market Deeping. At the roundabout turn right along the A16 through Spalding and Boston. After another mile bear right on the A52 to Skegness finishing at THE FORESHORE CENTRE.

IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT AT APPROXIMATELY 34 MILES competitors must bear LEFT ALONG THE NEW FLYOVER OVER THE MAIN A1.

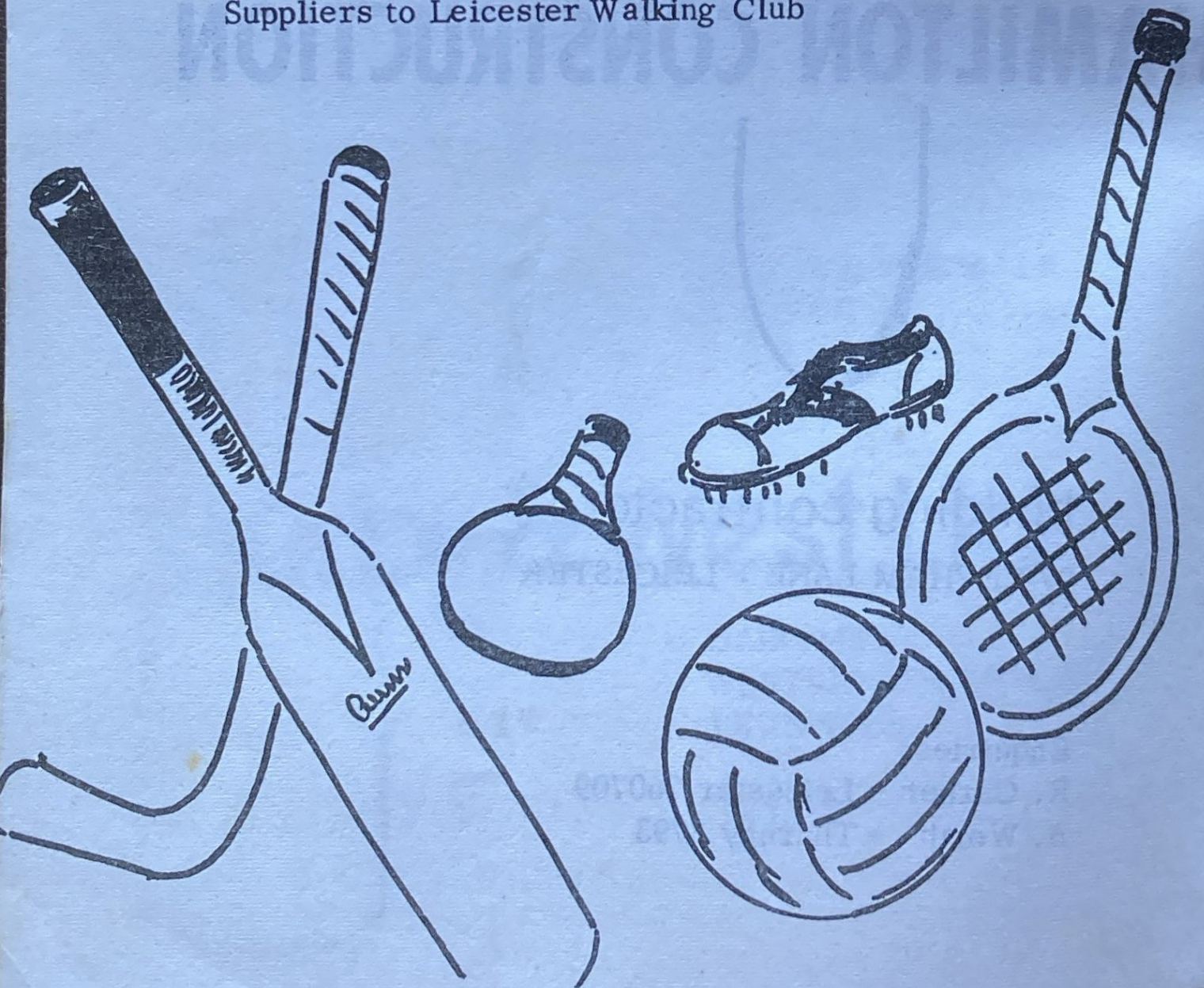

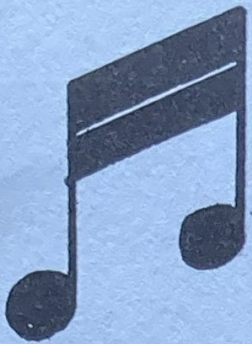

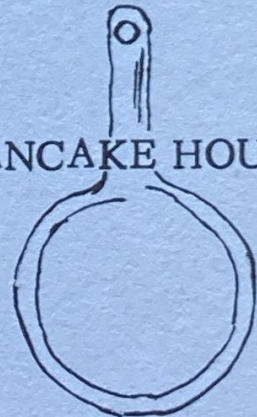
